

World Robot Olympiad Singapore 2026 - Terms and Conditions

1. This World Robot Olympiad Singapore 2026 (the "Competition") is organised by Space Faculty (the "Organiser"). By participating in this Contest, the participant agrees to be bound by the official rules, regulations and decisions of the Organiser.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to reject any registration forms with incomplete details.
3. No refund will be given to teams who withdraw from their participation.
4. A payment receipt will be emailed to the Team Leader and/or Mentor when the Organiser receives the completed registration form and payment.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any entrant and/or winner in its absolute discretion for any reason.
6. The judges' decision is final and binding. As such, no correspondence will be entered into.
7. Prizes are non-transferable and non-exchangeable. If any prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Organiser reserves the right to replace the prizes with other items of an equivalent value.
8. The Organiser takes no responsibility for prizes damaged or lost in transit and will not be responsible for any delay in delivery, damage to or loss in transit of the prize.
9. Personal data: The Organiser is committed to protecting your privacy. All information gathered from your registration form or website is confidential.
10. Each registrant's personal data is collected to enable the Organiser to administer and promote this Competition and the winner.
11. Participants, coaches, and parents are expected to maintain a standard of respectful and professional behaviour throughout the course. Disruptive or disrespectful conduct may result in course dismissal without a refund.

Any such modifications will be communicated to participants in a timely manner, and we will make every effort to minimize disruptions to the learning experience.

14. By submitting this Registration Form, you agree that the Organiser may collect, use and disclose your personal data, as provided in this application form to sponsoring companies and/or partners of the Organiser when required.
